NOTES

- Open-pollinated species, with some exceptions, may not come true from seed. Cultivars, except for a few perennials, do not come true. Plants from these seeds should be labelled as being "ex" that species or cultivar.

- When sowing rhododendrons on peat we recommend you sterilize it first. Microwave it for 15 minutes or pour boiling water through it several times. Allow it to cool.
- We would like to thank the seed donors for their time and effort making crosses, collecting and cleaning seeds.
- **Notes from Norman Cochrane's Crosses**

'Anderson(N)' & 'Anderson(S)' are two individual mature plants grown from Anderson cross ARHS 2004-60: [('Yellow Pippin' x 'Cat's Pajamas') x ('Janet Blair' x Yellow #1)] x [('Percy Wiseman' x (Yellow #1 x 'Jet Set')) x 'Capistrano' where Yellow #1 is: [(wardii x hemsleyanum) x 'Autumn Gold']]. Both are strong yellows. 'Anderson (S)' has a vigorous growth habit with large, initially peach, blooms turning to clear yellow. 'Anderson (N)' is weaker growing with smaller blooms of stable clear yellow. Both plants have been winter hardy in Lower Sackville except for failed blooming following the -25°C flash freeze of Feb. 3-4, 2023.

'ARS92-608' is clone of seedling #9 of Anderson cross: [('Big Deal' x 'Donna Hargrove') x ('Golden Star' x 'Catalga')] x wardii' grown by Bill Wilgenhof. Very attractive blooms – soft yellow grading to white at outer tips.

'Yellow *R. brachycarpum* hybrid' is either ARHS 2005-75 or ARHS 2006-46. Plant has *R. brachycarpum*-like leaves and small yellow flowers.

'Pink & white bi-colour': On purchase, this attractive plant, which also sports a yellow center, was suggested to be 'Unique Marmalade' but seems much too hardy in spite of superficial resemblances.

'Cherokee' x 'Cassanova' is a Jack Looye cross grown from seed offering ARHS 2007-67. It displays large white petals with dull peach-orange backsides.

'Golden Flare' x 'Golden Lights', now a mature plant, could be mistaken for its pollen parent but on close examination shows larger blooms, modestly brighter colours, and a taller growth habit - cold tolerance unknown.
