Homebush azalea 1gal \$44 Zone 4 - 2.5m / 8ft



Homebush Azalea is a show-stopping deciduous shrub, featuring stunning balls of deep pink blooms in late spring. These blooms are made up of semi-double, trumpet-shaped flowers that create a striking display in the garden. Perfect for borders, hedges, or privacy screens, this plant also attracts butterflies, hummingbirds, and other pollinators. It thrives in rich, acidic soil with good drainage, ensuring healthy growth and vibrant flowers. With its bold colour and impressive form, Homebush Azalea is an excellent addition to any landscape.

Toucan azalea 1gal \$44 Zone 4 - 2.5m / 8ft



An open, multi-stemmed deciduous shrub that fills the spring air with a vibrant display of white and yellow blooms before the leaves emerge. Its green foliage turns a striking orange in the fall, adding seasonal interest to your landscape. This hardy shrub thrives in well-drained, rich acidic soil and requires proper drainage for optimal growth. Prune after flowering to maintain its shape and encourage healthy growth.

Mandarin Lights azalea 2gal \$71 Zone 3 - 1.5m / 5ft



A deciduous shrub that dazzles with vivid orange-red, fragrant flowers in late spring. The blooms precede the appearance of the green leaves, which turn a striking purple in the fall. This azalea is excellent for attracting pollinators like bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds, adding life to your garden. It thrives in rich, acidic soil with good drainage, ensuring healthy growth and vibrant seasonal changes.

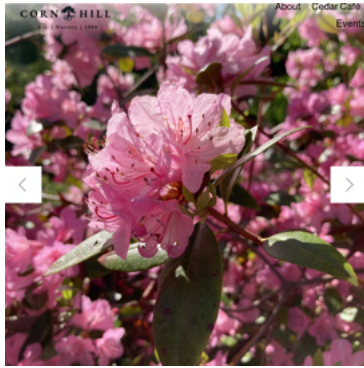
Haaga Rhododendron 1gal \$44 2gal \$71 Zone 4 - 2m / 6.5ft



Haaga, a standout variety from Finland, is a dense, multi-stemmed evergreen shrub known for its striking dark pink clusters of flowers that bloom in May. Its glossy green foliage persists through winter, providing year-round interest. This rhododendron thrives in well-drained, rich

acidic soil and attracts hummingbirds, butterflies, and bees, making it a fantastic addition to pollinator-friendly gardens. As one of the hardiest rhododendrons, Haaga is an excellent choice for northern climates.

Olga Rhododendron 2gal \$71 Zone 4 - 2m / 6.5ft



Olga is a small-leaved rhododendron that dazzles with an abundant display of clear pink flowers in late spring. Its shiny, aromatic green leaves transition to a beautiful copper-burgundy hue in the fall, adding seasonal interest to your garden. This variety thrives in well-drained, acidic soil and benefits from regular pruning to remove spent flowers, encouraging new growth and a better display the following year.

Ramapo Rhododendron 1gal \$44 2gal \$71 Zone 4 - 50cm / 1.5ft



Ramapo is a stunning rhododendron that produces a profusion of light violet flowers in early to mid-spring, offering a vibrant pop of colour to your garden. Its aromatic evergreen leaves begin with a bluish hue, maturing to a blue-green before transitioning to a beautiful bronze colour in fall and winter. This hardy shrub thrives in well-drained, acidic soil, making it perfect for a variety of garden settings. Ramapo attracts butterflies, hummingbirds, and other pollinators, making it a wonderful choice for enhancing biodiversity in your landscape.

Calsap Rhododendron 1gal \$44 2gal \$71 Zone 4b - 1.5m / 5ft



Calsap Rhododendron is an evergreen shrub known for its stunning clusters of lavender-white flowers with a striking dark purple flare on the upper lobe. Its emerald green foliage remains lush and vibrant throughout the year, even in winter, as it holds on for two full seasons. This rhododendron thrives in full sun, which promotes a denser growth habit and encourages prolific blooming, typically starting in mid to late season, around late May to early June. It requires well-drained, rich acidic soil for optimal health and performance

PJM Rhododendron 1gal \$44 2gal \$71

Rhodora canadense 1gal \$44 Zone 3 - 75cm / 2.5ft



Rhodora is a beautiful native rhododendron known for its vibrant lavender-pink flowers that bloom in spring. This low-growing deciduous shrub thrives in damp, even swampy conditions, but can also adapt to well-drained soils. Its grey-green leaves, covered with indumentum on the underside, offer a distinctive texture. Rhodora prefers moist, acidic soils and benefits from full sun to achieve the best flowering display. A fantastic choice for adding native beauty and color to your landscape, while supporting local pollinators like bees and butterflies.
