### PERENNIALS

*Alcea rosea* 'Mars Magic' (Mars Magic Hollyhock) - A perennial strain with bright red single flowers. Good dark green basal mounded foliage. Grows to 6'(1.8m) tall. Zone 4. (1 gal. - \$18.00 / 6"Dp pots - \$14.00)



*Anemone ranunculoides* (Yellow Wood Anemone) - A deciduous rhizomatous perennial for part or deciduous shade. Its bright golden yellow anemone flowers are born above dissected dark green foliage in spring. Best in loose, rich soil. Grows 6-8"(15-20cm) high spreading to form a loose clump. Goes dormant in summer. Zone 5. (3.5" pots - \$10.00)

These rare semi-double to double-flowered named cultivars from Estonia are also available. As it is difficult to describe the subtle differences between the cultivars it is best to look them up on-line. (3.5" pots - \$16.00)

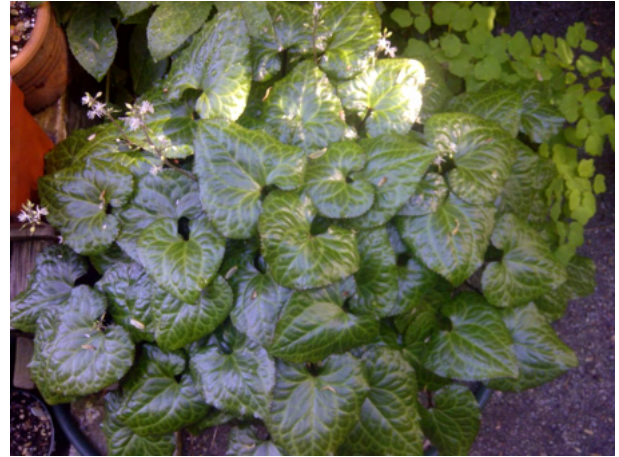

*Athyrium grammitoides* - A hardy and apparently rare in cultivation fern which may or may not have another half dozen names. I'll stick this one as any research I've done has left me more confused. This is a dense colony forming deciduous species with thin stems. Forms clumps 8"-12"(.2-.3m) high. Resents drought - it will go dormant at the first sign of it. Shade to part shade. Zone 5, possibly colder. (4"Dp pots - \$12.00)

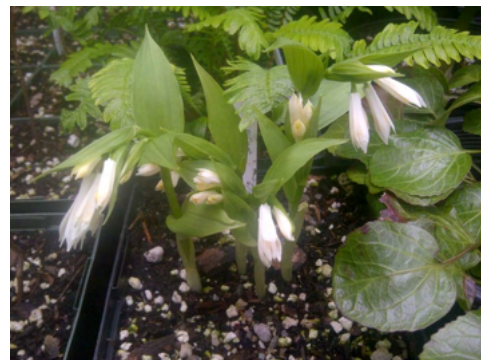


*Beesia deltophylla* - A semi-evergreen mounding perennial with glossy dark green heart-shaped foliage on long petioles. Foliage emerges with a purple tinge and takes on purple tones in winter. Small white flowers are borne in spikes to 18"(45cm) high in late spring and summer. Shade to part shade. Zone 6. (3.5" pots - \$14.00)



*Digitalis grandiflora* (Yellow Foxglove) - A reliably perennial species with spikes of creamy-yellow flowers in summer. Remove spent flowers to encourage rebloom. To 2'(60cm) tall, usually less. Sun to part shade. Zone 4. (4"Dp pot - \$15.00 / 3.5" pots - \$12.00)

*Disporum megalanthum* - A rare species with clusters of pendulous white flowers in spring. Grows to 24"(60cm) tall. Part-shade. Zone 6. (4"Dp pots - \$24.00)



*Phytolacca clavifera* (*P. polyandra*) (**Chinese Poke Weed**) - A stout perennial with bottle-brush-like dense racemes of fluffy pink flowers which are followed by inedible glossy fruit resembling blackberries. Grows to 4'(1.2m) high. Full sun. Zone 6. **(6" Dp pots - \$14.00)**



## **RHODODENDRONS & AZALEAS**

*Azalea 'Paestrina'* - A Vuyk hybrid evergreen azalea with funnel-shaped white flowers with green spotting. To 5'(1.5m) high. Zone 6. **(4" Dp pots - \$18.00)**



*Rhododendron albrechtii* - A Japanese deciduous azalea species with thick textured, flat-faced flowers early in spring. Slow growing with an upright twiggy habit. These are seed grown from seed from a good purple-pink clone. Zone 6 possibly colder. Choice. **(6" Dp pots - \$25.00)**



*Rhododendron 'April Rhapsody'* - ('April Gem' x 'Vibrant Violet') Clear purple flowers in early spring. To 30"(75cm) high in 10 years with a dense habit. Zone 6. **(3.5" pots - \$15.00)**

***Rhododendron dauricum* 'Ruth Wainwright'** - A very early blooming and nearly deciduous species retaining only a few leaves at the branch tips in winter. This cultivar - grown from wild-collected seed from Hokkaido by Walter Ostrom - has purple flowers and is a floriferous and reliable bloomer. To 4'(1.2m) high x 6'(1.8m) wide with an upright habit. Best in full sun and requires excellent drainage. Zone 5. (3.5" pots - \$18.00)



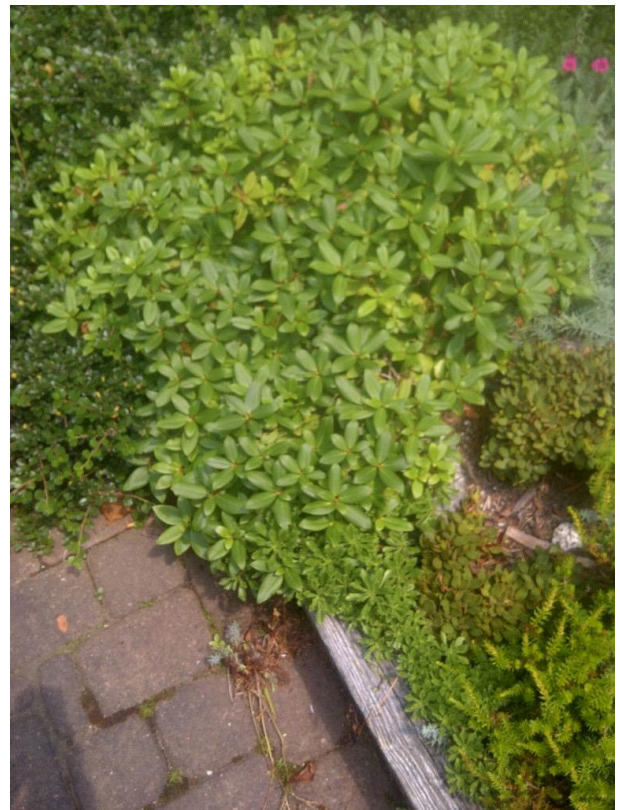
***Rhododendron* 'Deming Brook'** - (*keiskei* 'Yaku Fairy' open-pollinated) A very dwarf Lincoln Foster hybrid with creamy-white flowers blushed pale pink. Foliage similar to *R. keiskei*. Dense mounded habit growing only 8"(.2m) high x 16"(.4m) wide in 10 years. Zone 6, possibly colder. (3.5" pots - \$15.00)



***Rhododendron (impeditum x 'Bluette')* Brueckner G-33-06** - A low dense growing Joseph Brueckner hybrid with striking purple-blue flowers and small leaves. Zone 5. (4"Dp pots - \$18.00)



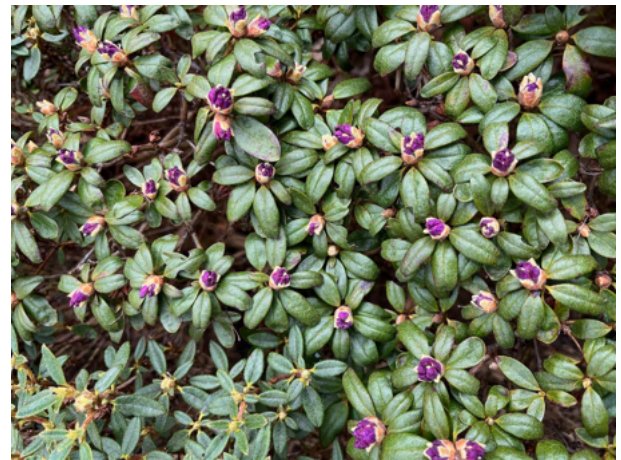
***Rhododendron (minus v. chapmanii x ludlowii)*** - An Augie Kehr hybrid with pale yellow flowers and a dwarf habit. To 12"(.3m) high x 2'(.6m) wide in 10 years. Burgundy winter colour. Zone 6. (6"Dp pots - \$25.00)





**Rhododendron 'Ptarmigan'** - (*leucaspis* x *orthocladum* v. *microleucum*) Pure white flowers with dark brown anthers. Dark green foliage. 16-24"(40-60cm) high. Mildest parts of Zone 6. (4"Dp pots - \$18.00)

**Rhododendron 'Pikeland'** - (*keiskei* x *campylogynum*) White flowers edged pink. Compact, to 3'(90cm) high and wide. Zone 6b. (4"Dp pots - \$18.00)



**Rhododendron [(*russatum* x *pemakoense*) x *keiskei* 'Yaku Fairy']** - A hybrid grown from Barry Starling seed - unique, a blue dwarf *keiskei* 'YF' hybrid. Shiny green leaves unlike other dwarf, compact blues. 8"(20cm) high by 12"(30cm) wide in 15 years. Zone 5b. (4"Dp pots - \$18.00)



**Rhododendron 'Scotian Bells'** - (*mucronulatum* v. *chejuense* x *campylogynum* Charoepum Group) A Weagle hybrid with loose trusses pendant campanulate violet-purple flowers. Early. Low compact habit. Can be deciduous in winter. Zone 6b. (4"Dp pots - \$18.00)



## BULBS

*Erythronium dens-canis* (Dog Tooth Violet) - These are named cultivars with lost labels. Mauve-pink flowers with recurved petals are held above a pair of leaves that are heavily mottled with bronze. Early spring blooming. Part-shade. Zone 4. (3.5" pots (3 bulbs) - \$14.00)



## OTHER ERICACEOUS SHRUBS

*Menziesia ciliicalyx* v. *purpurea* (now *Rhododendron benhalii*) - A deciduous shrub growing to 2'(60cm) high with a shrubby mounded habit. Its urn-shaped flowers are purplish pink and are held in loose drooping clusters. Zone 6. **These are open-pollinated seedlings.** (6"Dp pots - \$25.00)

*Pieris japonica* 'Suzuki'?? - A very compact cultivar which we are not sure of the name and can find little reference to it. Panicles of white, lily-of-the-valley-like flowers appear in spring from buds formed the previous year. (3.5" pots - \$15.00)
